The Colorado Section ARES hosts two voice nets each Sunday morning. The first is at 08:00 local on a frequency of 3.810± Mhz. This is an HF frequency so the use of a horizontally polarized antenna is recommended.

The second voice net is at 08:30 hours on a frequency of 145.310 Mhz courtesy of the Colorado Connection. A 123 Hz tone is required.

The Colorado Section ARES hosts a digital net on the first and third Sunday of each month at 07:30 local on a frequency of 3.590 MHz. There is also a CW net on the second and fourth Sunday of each month at 07:30 local on a frequency of 3.570 MHz.
