If you are an experienced HFer, then sit down at a radio and see what you can do. We are encouraging all CW operators to sign up and help us get points.

If you are doing your own Field Day event then when you enter your event summary into the ARRL upload form, **please enter LONGMONT AMATEUR RADIO CLUB** in the form as your association (use your own call sign though).

Location is **Izaak Walton Park** located down the hill from 3rd avenue on Sunset, next to the river in Longmont. We have the whole park including the outdoor pavilion and the air conditioned meeting room. We plan on setting up our radios in the meeting room.

Saturday

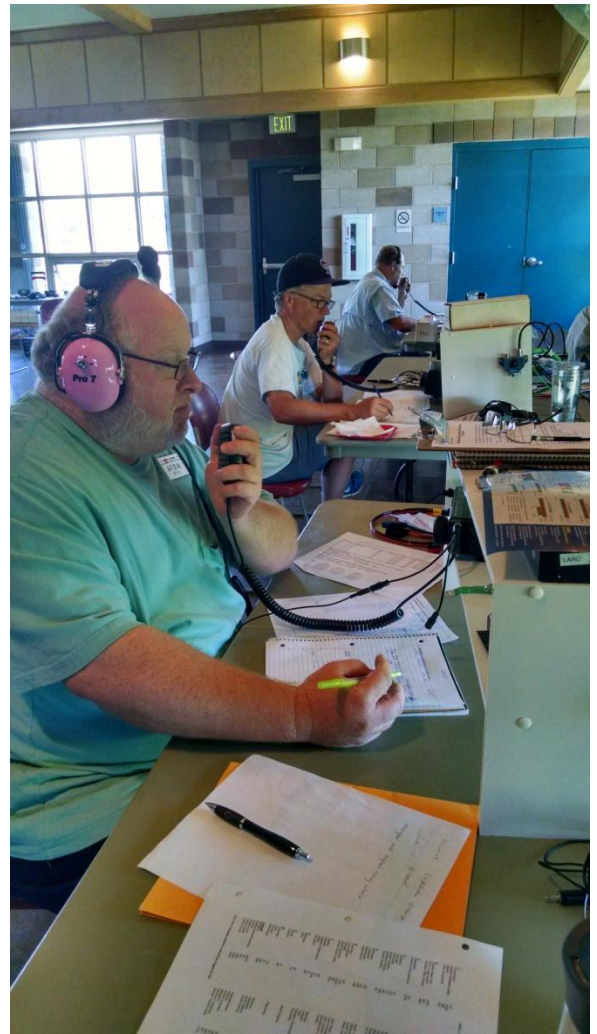
10:00 am : Set up tables and chairs, and club radios and antennas (6 - 8 helpers needed).

12:00 noon: Field day starts for Colorado at 12:00 noon MDT

Sunday

12:00 noon we shut down. Here we need 8 or more helpers tearing down and putting away and cleaning up. We must be gone by 1:00pm

band you are interested in (40, 20, 15). *Those who sign up for a time and band have priority for the radio on that band.*
